DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

For anyone that is interested, consider an extended time studying works of systematic theology on the existence of angels. Consider exploring online resources, referring to any books your group might have access to, or contact our church office for recommendations.

Have someone read 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. What does it mean that communion 'proclaims' the Lord's death? Why is our proclamation in communion centered around his death (perhaps in comparison with his life or his resurrection)? What do you make out of the last phrase 'until he comes'?

Applying

Do you believe angels are present and active in our world today? If so, what efforts are they engaged in, and what does it mean for the people of God to be conscious and even receptive to their efforts?

It seems that lately our church family is increasingly being challenged and spurred to be active in our invitations and introductions to others towards the truths and celebrations of our faith. Is that an active part of your life of faith and worship? Why or why not?
