‘Bread to Bread’

Matthew 26:26, Luke 24:13-35

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week’s sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

Can anyone recall stories in Scripture where bread is prominent, beyond this weekend’s passages? How about bread’s importance in different cultures?

Have someone read 1 Kings 19:11-12. In light of this passage, this weekend’s sermon, and maybe also other examples you can consider, discuss why God chooses to show himself in our lives in veiled, even unclear ways.

Applying

When has God shown up in unexpected ways in your life?

We often view our spiritual relationship with Jesus being engaged only when we’re ready and posture ourselves in a certain way. Pastor Donny’s message reminds us that he pursues us and walks with us whether we’re ready or recognize him or not. How does that make you feel or what implications might that have?

Praying

Take some time as a group and pray over people impacted by the war in the Ukraine. May the Lord bring an end to the violence and destruction taking place and healing to people and nations.

Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for?
How can we pray for our church?
