DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

While there are often lingering consequences when we make sinful choices, God clearly does not operate in a way that ensures we always 'get what we deserve'. Read Psalm 103:10, Romans 6:23, and 2 Corinthians 5:21 and discuss the dichotomy between consequences and grace.

With all of the conversation in this chapter about sight, blindness, and eyes being open (and yet not seeing), refer to Genesis 3:7 and discuss what this imagery means.

Applying

What is your experience with baptism (your personal background, how it has been facilitated and celebrated in the life of the church, questions you have, etc.)?

If refusing God in any way is illogical, why do we so often allow ourselves the option? Is there any specific part of your faith that you are reluctant or confused about that those around you can support and pray for you about?

Praying

In light of this message and discussion:

How can we pray for each other?

Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for?

How can we pray for our church?
