DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

Reading Acts 3:1-3, explore the personal background, story, frustrations, and unexpected transformation of the man lame from birth.

Leading up to the parable of the sower that Pastor John briefly introduced, we read that Jesus's fame and influence was mightily growing. Use other parables and do an overview of the types of parables Jesus told and then who he was telling them to. Are there any observations you can draw from the intentionality of the parable content and the audience of that parable (or a collection of parables)?

Applying

What is your greatest personal threat to spiritually and relationally allowing God's Word and God's will to grow deep, lasting roots in your life?

What does 'contagious worship', like we saw in Acts 3, look like in our world today? Have you had experience with anything like that? Would you like experience like that?
