DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

Read Psalm 46 in three sections at the 'Selah' points. Practice what the author instructs you to do, pausing and reflecting ('selah') on what you just read.

Read Matthew 22:32 and Acts 3:13 (among many others we could study). Discuss the significance of God identifying himself alongside his people? What does it mean that God ties his reputation and his identity to his people?

Applying

Because God's people 'shall not be moved' even amidst all of the turmoil and struggle of the world, in what ways can we put greater dependance and faith in the Lord of Hosts? How can we provoke our souls to greater confidence and solidarity in Him?

What are practical steps you can take this week to slacken and release ('rapa' - part of being still and knowing God is God)?
