DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

Have someone read Ephesians 4:26-27. Anger itself is not sinful, but there is opportunity for us to sin in (or because of) our anger. Discuss where you think that 'line' might be.

Do you think God 'takes sides' in any of our conflicts with people? Is there a better term or perspective than 'taking sides'? How might we strive to ensure we are living in such a way that God will defend us? Read Psalm 35:1 and then Isaiah 49:25 to help serve as a foundation for discussion.

Applying

Discuss what you generally do with your anger (release, stifle, internalize, etc.).

In honest and grace, consider sharing some instances when people in your group have dealt with anger well and perhaps not so well.

Praying

In light of this message and discussion:

How can we pray for each other?

Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for?

How can we pray for our church?
