

God's Nature – Tracing His Fingerprints 'People'

Genesis 1:26-27, Hebrews 1:3

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

Have someone read Hebrews 1:1-3. Where people have fallen short as representatives of God, Christ fulfilled it in entirety and perfection. Consider the examples before the time of Christ and the ways they did or did not represent the Lord God to his people.

Have someone read Isaiah 43:10-12. God invites us into witnessing, testifying, and representing him to the world. Discuss the weight of that calling and ways that we succeed and struggle with it.

Applying

If Connections are so central to this particular church's plan (and in engaging this resource, likely you're doing it within the context of a Connection), can you think of anyone you can invite to join you or connect with another Connection that is a fit for them?

As we invite in each week's studies, we want to challenge people to engage in the element of God's Nature that the message talked about (in this case, people). Consider taking some time in a public place and doing some 'people watching'. What comes to mind as you consider the nature of God in this aspect of God's nature?

Praying

In light of this message and discussion:

How can we pray for each other?
Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for?
How can we pray for our church?
