## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

*The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.*

### **Listening**

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

### **Engaging**

Jesus does not want the children prevented from coming to him because the kingdom of heaven belongs to those like them (see also Luke 18:17, stressing 'childlike faith'). What qualities is God after in this?

In saying 'Let no one despise you for your youth', Paul is also talking about people that are young in their faith. What qualities in 'young faith' might God also be after in lives of all believers? What do we tend to lose as time passes?

### **Applying**

What can you do this week to demonstrate (or cultivate) a value of the youth around you?

How have the youth around you been an example in speech? In conduct? In love? In faith? In purity?

### **Praying**

In light of this message and discussion:

How can we pray for each other?

Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for?

How can we pray for our church?
