Living Whole in a Fractured World: A Letter from James "Whole People Overlook No One"

October 23-24, 2021

This provides about one hour of discussion, music and readings. Use the portions you find most helpful.

Open with James 1:26-27 and Leviticus 19:15, and briefly review last week's message.

1. Who is overlooked? Read Psalm 68:5, Isaiah 1:17 and John 4:35.

2. Pure religion is both purity **of action** and purity **of heart**.

- Read James 1:27, 1 Samuel 16:7. Luke 6:44-45, and Romans 12:2.
- In <u>Why Emotions Matter</u>, Tristen and Jonathan Collins wrote, "... You might not have control over which thoughts appear randomly in your mind, but you do have control over where your thought train goes from there... You have control over the beliefs you choose to embrace and the beliefs you challenge." Read 2 Corinthians 10:4-5. How do these ideas work, in practical ways? How well do I control my thoughts?
- What are some strategies we can use to live in purity, both in heart and action?
- In **James 1:26-27**, why do you think that James emphasized these three specific actions when defining true "religion?"
- Watch a 3-minute excerpt of Francis Chan discussing these verses in James (beginning at 8:12 minutes until 11:47) at

 - How might we show "care" for the truly needy?
- 3. God's Kingdom comes with a different **value system**.
 - Read Luke 14:1-14. How can I apply Jesus's instruction in my own situation? To do that, what needs to change in me?
 - Discuss this Tim Keller quote: "The gospel is this: We **are more sinful and flawed** in ourselves than we ever dared believe, yet at the very same time **we are more loved and accepted** in Jesus Christ than we ever dared hope."
 - Read Ezekiel 18:23, Romans 6:23, Romans 3:22-26, and 1 Timothy 2:1-6. Who needs the gospel... beyond me?
 - Read **2 Corinthians 5:14-21** and N.T. Wright's quote: *"Our task ... is to announce redemption... I believe if we face the question, "if not now, then when?" if we are grasped by this vision, we may also hear the question, "if not us, then who?" And if the gospel of Jesus is not the key to this task, then what is?"*
 - What connections do you notice between these passages and the unreached/overlooked in the world?
 - **Challenge**: Ask God to show me who He would have me notice; ask for His wisdom to know the best way that I can help.
