DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

The following questions are intended to use in discussion and application of the past week's sermon.

Listening

What part of the sermon was most helpful to you or challenged you to think and/or live differently? How will you apply this message to your life?

Engaging

For cruel reasons, people would often contribute to the suffering of blind people, enough that God had to issue laws prohibiting the mistreatment of the blind. Read Deuteronomy 27:18 and Leviticus 19:14 and discuss this and other ways in which the life and teachings of Jesus fulfill and expand on the heart of God in Old Testament.

People often forget that the parable of the Prodigal Son is fictional. Because it is fiction, that means the details that Jesus chooses to include are purposeful. What details in this parable (Luke 15:11-32 stand out to you?

Applying

What are your thoughts on Hell? How often do you consider what it is that we are saved from by the life and love of Jesus?

Is there anyone that you can invite to church? How can you be even more active and intentional about bringing people along with you on the journey of discovering, celebrating, and proclaiming our amazing grace?

Praying

In light of this message and discussion:

How can we pray for each other? Where do you feel challenged or convicted?

What can we praise God for? How can we pray for our church?
